



The new Auditorium of Lugo was born as the main building of the "Plan Hurbe" Project, and will probalby become the most important public building of Lugo. It was designed by the Madrid based architectural studio Paredes Pedrosa and hosts two music halls of 900 and 300 seats located over the mountain slope - while facing the garden, both venues get all natural light from outside.

The key element of the slim chair used are the walnut backrest and seat shells which seem to "fly" over the venue - they are fixed to the floor with two slim laser cut steel plates that also act as support for the solid wooden armrests
